Introduction / Our Policy

Thank you for completing this application and for your interest in volunteering with us! It is the policy of this organization to provide equal opportunities to all individuals without regard to race, color, creed, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, marital or veteran status, or presence of a non-job-related handicap. However, wolves and wolfdogs are large, strong, and potentially dangerous animals, and the work we do is often physically strenuous. Many tasks will require volunteers to walk for extended distances, stand for extended periods, lift up to 50 lbs, bend over, and maneuver heavy objects. Volunteers may also be exposed to animal dander/fur, dirt and dust, disinfectants and other chemicals, and potentially dangerous tools, and should be prepared to work in all environmental conditions including heat, cold, and rain.

If you have any questions regarding the type of work you would best be suited for, please feel free to ask. Note that for legal reasons, Junior Volunteers (16-17 years) are restricted in the duties they may perform—see our website for more information.

Commitment: Our ideal volunteer should be able to commit to coming consistently a certain day a week for an indefinite period of time.

Reliability: All volunteers must be accountable and responsible. We must be able to trust that you will consistently follow all directions, be eager to learn, come when we are expecting you, and communicate with us if there are any scheduling conflicts or other problems.

Respect: We expect all our volunteers to treat our animals (as well as other people) with tremendous respect and caring. Mistreatment of any kind, or failure to abide by our safety rules, will not be tolerated. And always remember that most of our animals are non-domestic and potentially dangerous animals, NOT pets or cute dogs! Volunteers are not guaranteed contact with any animals.

Positions: SFWS offers a variety of Volunteer roles. Kitchen Assistant, On-site Tour Guides, and Grounds Crew volunteers have no minimum number of hours required to volunteer and help with kitchen aid, diet prep, grounds keeping, and other similar tasks, but do not have direct access to the animals. A Keeper Aide Volunteer is a competitive position for those hoping to be more experienced animal caretakers, with a time commitment requirement and approval from the Curator. Event and Administrative volunteers will come down to the discretion of the Executive Director. By your signature of this application, you assert that you have read and understand these policies.
